- The graphic novel must have at least eight panels.
- · Theme options for the graphic novel are: resiliency, hope, family, unity

March 10 - April 13, 2025

- The registration form below must be completed and attached to the graphic novel when dropped off.
- All graphic novels MUST be turned into an EVPL location or submitted via email by 5:00 pm on April 12 or can be turned in at EVPL Central on April 13 with the registration form below. No late entries will be accepted.

Two winners will be awarded based on the content and design of their graphic novel.

Winners will:

- receive free admission to the VIP reception for Ralph Shayne on April 16.
- introduce Ralph Shayne at the SPEAK event on April 16.
- receive a copy of Hour of Need by Ralph Shayne.
