- Submissions can be handwritten or typed and can include simple illustrations or adornment.
- Final pieces should be no larger than 8.5 x 11.
- Poems can be dropped off between the dates of April 15 June 1, 2025 at any EVPL location.
- Digital submissions may be emailed to *programming@evpl.org*, also between **April 15 June 1**.
- If you would like your original poem returned to you, please indicate such on the submission form. They will be available for pick-up at your selected location **June 23 July 6**.
- The registration form must be completed and attached to the poem when submitted.
